Why Should I Foster?

What Does A Foster Family Do?

What does a foster family do? A foster home provides the dog with food, water, indoor shelter, grooming and training, and will administer medication if necessary. The foster family provides love and socialization. The foster family should commit to keeping the dog until placed for adoption. The foster family will be asked to evaluate the dog in their care. Is the dog good with children, other dogs or cats? The foster family should expose the dog to as many different situations as possible in order to know the dog and what type of home the dog would do best in.
